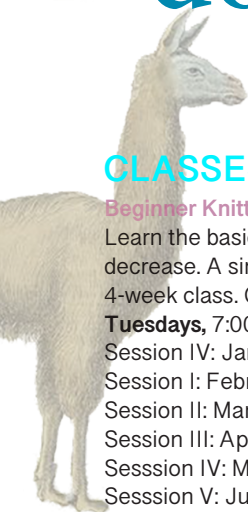

HATS FOR BEGINNERS

This class will explore the various ways of making a hat in the round. Use of circular and double-pointed needles will be discussed. When you know the basics, there's no end to the hat styles you can make.
